Maths

In preparation for the Maths GCSE paper 1 (non-calculator) all pupils have been given a Predicted Paper 2025 to work through. This paper has video solutions so pupils can mark their work once completed. Individual class teachers will go through any difficulties in lessons.

In addition, pupils have their Maths Exam Practice workbook. Pupils are encouraged to complete any pages they have started in class. Answers are in the back of the book so pupils can mark their work. There are also additional Practice Papers in the back of the book.

Pupils have all been given their updated list of consistent weakness and linked Maths Watch videos. To improve, pupils need to watch the highlighted videos and attempt the interactive questions on MathsWatch on their identified consistent weakness topics.
